#### **About Dussmann Group**

With almost 65,000 employees in 21 countries, the Dussmann Group is a multi-service provider offering a range of diverse solutions including facilities management, plant engineering, nursing and childcare services. Since it was founded in 1965, the company has dedicated itself to providing services that put people first and since 2018, sustainability management has been a key pillar of this strategy. This makes Dussmann a great example of performance sustainability - an ethos that focuses on people, profitability and the planet for a sustainable future.



#### Challenge

Dussmann Group was keen to calculate carbon footprint data for all company divisions and across all services. In the process, it needed to record and analyze 77 indicators required for international sustainability reporting. With 376 staff members around the world all required to input data, this was a vast project – and one which Excel spreadsheets were ill-suited to tackle!

### Collecting sustainability data was time-consuming

In the past, Dussmann's QHSE team ran into list-based chaos, battling a jungle of data created by erratic data administration, multiple entries and incorrectly converted energy units. In fact, in 2020, it took the team over five months to collate numerous spreadsheets, identify and rectify incorrect entries, and make the necessary calculations.

Head of Group QHSE at Dussmann Group, Daniel Krebel, said: "In the past, we were only able to view our indicators after the various company divisions had collated their information in Excel lists and finally handed it over to us. Now, we can track every input value in real time and intervene directly if needed." 65,000

#### **Solution**

In order to get a handle on its sustainability capabilities, the Dussmann Group turned to AMCS to provide a software solution. Group QHSE Specialist at Dussmann Group, Daria Steinbock, explained: "We have now defined 250 indicators in the AMCS Sustainability software. We're able to track precisely how much electricity is being consumed, how much fuel our vehicle fleet is using, and how much district heating we need in different company divisions, to name just a few examples."

### AMCS Sustainability Platform simplifies emissions reporting

Rather than collating data through a series of emails and Excel spreadsheets, the team is now able to automate and streamline data entry using a standardized process that requires minimal coordination and improves data quality. Not only does this improve accuracy, it also accelerates reporting to international sustainability standards.

This streamlined process allowed the team to implement a market-based approach for Scope 1 and 2 emissions in accordance with the GHG Protocol for the entire Dussmann Group. As a result, they were able to produce a fully consolidated, auditable carbon footprint for the first time.

#### **Results**

Since 2021, the Dussmann
Group has relied on the AMCS
Sustainability Platform to produce its
non-financial reports. It enables the
QHSE team to input all necessary
indicators online, monitor them
in real time, and intervene swiftly
during the reporting process if any
problems arise. Using a dashboard
to analyze relevant KPIs helps the
team visualize carbon emissions
and also forms the basis for setting
quantitative sustainability targets.

### Accessible data is key to setting sustainability targets

Using the AMCS analytics dashboard, the Dussmann team can clearly understand the total greenhouse gas emissions at any time, along with the KPIs derived from it, while also filtering the results by business unit. Not only that, for the first time, the Dussmann Group can use these outputs to define quantifiable sustainability targets for the years ahead – an important milestone for any truly sustainable company that wants to boost profitability and look after the planet.
